Join us on Tuesday, October 27th at noon for our first Prandium Lunchtime Seminar of the term with Tyler Carson.

Tyler will give a presentation entitled:

“Loving (M)Others: Queer Narcissism in Alison Bechdel’s *Are you My Mother?*”

Tyler’s paper argues that Alison Bechdel’s meticulous archive of familial memories in her second graphic novel, *Are You My Mother?*, serves as a valuable resource for thinking about the complicated nature of mother-daughter relations, as well as provides us with a roadmap to track the often difficult process of learning how to live with one’s queerness in the social world.

Tyler Carson is an MA student in Women and Gender Studies at the University of Toronto. He holds a Social Science and Humanities Canada Graduate Scholarship. Tyler recently completed and submitted his Master’s Research Paper, which was titled *When Queer Meets World: Affect, Narcissism, Reparation*.
