


## Roles & Responsibilities

- Better understanding of energy industry, market players, the relationships between them, and the role of consultants




AMI Benefit-Cost Analysis Validation for a Canadian Utility

#### Input




Benefit-cost analysis (BCA) provided by client, sample of BCAs performed by other North American utilities
