Task

Challenges

- Few companies are willing to explicitly commit to the United Nations Declaration on the Rights of Indigenous Peoples (UNDRIP) and/or free, prior, and informed consent (FPIC).
- Companies in sectors that do not directly operate on Indigenous lands show to be less progressive in advancing reconciliation compared to the latter.

Insights and Skills Gained

- Developed a deeper knowledge and understanding of TRC's Call to Action 92 and the important role it plays in responsible investing.
- Analytical skills gained through data collection, interpretation and presentation of results using Microsoft Excel.

Key Takeaways

- > Say on Pay votes allow shareholders to register their approval or disapproval on executive compensation. Although these votes are only advisory, Say on Pay improves communication between shareholders and issuers on executive compensation.
- > Companies across ALL sectors have a role to play in advancing Indigenous reconciliation.
- > Sustainability reporting frameworks should develop more disclosures surrounding Indigenous rights and relations as a means of increasing reconciliation efforts.
