## **GROCERY RETAIL INDUSTRY CHALLENGES**

- Packaging The grocery-retail industry faces trade-offs such as reduced product shelf-life when packaging is changed or removed, leading to higher volumes of food wastage
- Customer Perception –
   Customers' standards for food such as produce lead to wastage of high-quality food with cosmetic damage such as bruises
