Tasks

- Researching new opportunities for engagement, focusing on biodiversity, toxic materials, and plastics
- Determining best practices for biodiversity engagement
- Researching just transition best practices that are applicable to the Canadian oil and gas sector
- Investigating companies in the Canadian oil and gas sector to determine the level of disclosure of climate lobbying practices

Challenges

- Limited information available on plastics and toxic materials
- Best practices for a just transition in Canada are not specific to oil and gas
- Oil and gas companies in Canada do not properly disclose climate lobbying practices
