Funding Criteria

- Event or project must fall within the 2017 calendar year
- Event or project must be innovative and unique to anniversary year
- Event or project should promote UTM's history, pride, culture and contributions made by UTM community members
- Event or project should showcase UTM's teaching and research excellence
- Event or project should drive greater alumni engagement
- Event or project should raise UTM's visibility as a leader and innovator
- Event or project should continue to build UTM's vital role in the city, region, country, globally

Other Considerations

1. Annual events are generally not considered for funding unless proposal makes strong connection to funding criteria above.
2. Program launch events are considered if proposal makes strong connection to funding criteria
3. Anniversary events/projects for programs or facilities are considered if proposal makes strong connection to funding criteria.
4. Subcommittee should try to ensure academic and administrative portfolio diversity in apportioning funds.
5. Subcommittee should ensure its decisions are transparent and accountable.
