



Change of Campus Affiliation

Graduate students are affiliated with a campus (St. George, UTM, or UTSC) based upon their program of study but may apply to change their campus affiliation if they meet the following criteria:

1. Student must be supervised by a member of the graduate faculty who is on the academic staff of the campus to which they wish to transfer affiliation;
2. Student must spend the majority of their academic time on the campus to which they wish to transfer affiliation.

Students will be identified by the School of Graduate Studies as affiliated with the campus indicated below (see Section 1) and will be charged the appropriate level of campus service fees for Athletics, Hart House, Health Service and other student services.
