

## ***FAQ's for Students - Take-Home Exams***

### **Student Questions:**

**Q. I am registered with Accessibility Services and I receive extra time accommodations to write my exams, but my instructor is now administering a take home exam and I am wondering if I will receive extra time?**

**A.** If your instructor has cancelled in-person exams and you are now completing a take home exam then your instructor may have built-in extra time for you to complete the take home exam. For example, the in- person exam was three hours long and your instructor is now giving you ten hours to complete the exam at home. If you have questions around this, please follow up with your Accessibility Advisor.

**Q. I am registered with Accessibility Services. Can I request an extension on my take home exam based on Accessibility-related reasons?**

**A.** If you are requesting an extension on your take home exam, please connect with your Accessibility Advisor.

**Q. How do I submit my take-home exam?**

**A.** Please monitor communication from your instructor who will inform you how to submit your take-home exam. For example, if the take home exam is being administered on Quercus you may be asked to upload the exam in Quercus by a specific date and time. Whereas some faculty may request you email them the completed take-home exam.
