



Membership Type	Eligibility
U of T Students	All U of T undergraduate students and UTM graduate students who have paid UTM incidental fees are already members of the Recreation, Athletics & Wellness Centre.
U of T Non-Registered Student Membership (Summer)	U of T students who have paid winter incidental fees, but not summer fees. This includes graduate students not paying summer incidental fees, or undergraduate students not taking summer courses.
U of T Alumni	U of T students who have graduated from an undergraduate or graduate degree program. A copy/photo of your diploma is required to confirm your eligibility.
U of T Staff/Faculty Joint Membership Plan B	Appointed U of T Staff and Faculty: Joint Membership Plan B is available by contacting UTM HR at hrserv.utm@utoronto.ca or 905-828-3935
U of T Non-appointed Employees	Non-appointed U of T staff (casuals, TAs, Unit 1, sessional instructors, UTM Chartwells). Must present a valid Letter of Employment.
Household members of Joint Membership Plan B members (18+)	Must provide proof of residency. Driver's license, copy of bills or bank statements are valid.
U of T Postdocs	Postdoctoral researchers or postdocs must present a recently dated letter on faculty or department letterhead indicating postdoctoral status. Offer of Employment letters are valid.
Seniors (65+)	Must present valid government ID with birthdate.
Community Members (18+)	Must present valid government ID with birthdate.
Day Pass	Must be 18+, or youth of staff/faculty 14+ if accompanied by staff/faculty. Must present valid government ID with birthdate.
