CAMPS AT A GLANCE (Updated Feb. 11, 2026)

MINI ADVENTURE CAMP

Ages: 4 - 5 Years

Fun filled and educational days for young minds to develop independence and physical literacy skills. Emphasis of this camp will be on play-based learning around a weekly educational theme. Activities will include fun physical activities and arts & crafts geared toward the weekly theme, and one fun splash day at the end of the week!

Note: There is no swimming offered in this camp program.

MULTI-SPORT CAMP

Ages: 6 - 7 Years, 8 - 9 Years, 10 - 11 Years, 12 - 14 Years

Multi-Sport is the most popular program at Camp U of T Mississauga! Campers have a blast in Multi-Sport with a daily variety of sports instruction, fun co-operative games, tournaments & weekly theme days. Registrations will be grouped by age category. Each category has curriculum tailored towards that specific age group based on developmentally appropriate activities. Recreational swimming is offered three times a week in this camp program.

RACQUET CAMP

Ages: 7 - 9 Years, 10 - 13 Years

Led by seasoned tennis instructors, campers will learn basic racquet strokes, develop motor skills, and play mini-games. This camp will introduce campers to tennis, badminton, squash (older campers only), table tennis, and pickleball. Recreational swimming is offered two times a week in this camp program.

SOCCER CAMP

Ages: 7 - 9 Years, 10 - 13 Years

Campers learn the fundamentals of soccer with a focus on ball control, shooting, passing, and team tactics such as attacking and defending. This is achieved through skill drills and structured scrimmage time. Please bring cleats and shin guards as well as water, a hat, sunscreen and a change of clothing. A majority of this camp will take place outdoors (weather permitting). Recreational swimming is offered two times a week in this camp program.

BASKETBALL CAMP

Ages: 9 - 11 Years, 12 - 14 Years

New to basketball or a seasoned baller, campers of all ability levels will improve with this fun and intensive week of basketball training! Campers work on the fundamentals of ball handling, passing, shooting and team tactics through drills and scrimmages. The focus is on skill development, fitness and fun! Recreational swimming is offered two times a week in this camp program.

DANCE CAMP

Ages: 5 - 7 Years, 8 - 12 Years

Explore dance, music, costume and prop design! Campers will learn a variety of dance styles including hip-hop, jazz, and creative dance. On the final day of each week, campers will show off what they learned in a dance recital performance for parents & guardians. Information about the performance will be sent home in the parent information package. Recreational swimming is offered twice a week in the older camp program, and a fun splash day at the end of the week for the younger camp program. Note: There is no swimming offered for the younger camp program.

NEW! LEADERS IN TRAINING (L.I.T.) CAMP

Ages: 12 - 14 Years

Take the first step in building confidence and leadership skills with the L.I.T. Program. Designed for young teens, this program introduces the responsibilities of camp leaders through fun and engaging activities, including team-building exercises, learning new camp games, developing presentation skills, peer-to-peer facilitation of games and activities, and a “How to Stand Out” session in partnership with the UTM Career Centre. Recreational swimming is offered two times a week in this camp program.

NEW! COUNSELLORS IN TRAINING (C.I.T.) CAMP

Ages: 15 - 17 Years

Interested in becoming a Camp Instructor at Camp UTM? This two-week Counsellors-in-Training (C.I.T.) program will prepare youth with essential leadership and camp counselling skills through hands-on training, including team-building activities, lesson planning, instructor shadowing, and facilitating camper activities. Participants also receive résumé and interview preparation in partnership with the UTM Career Centre. Successful C.I.T.s will earn two certifications: (1) HIGH FIVE® Principles of Healthy Child Development and (2) Standard First Aid with CPR Level C certifications, which will set them up to apply for future Camp Instructor roles. During the two weeks following their training, participants have the opportunity to have a placement in a camp program to complete up to 40 volunteer hours per week shadowing our Camp Instructors. Recreational swimming is offered two times a week in this camp program.

FORENSICS CAMPS - In Partnership with UTM's Forensics Department

Forensics I

Ages: 9 - 11 Years

Discover the fascinating world of forensic science. Dust for fingerprints, collect and analyze clues, and see science through the eyes of a forensic scientist. This camp provides a unique combination of fun, hands-on activities and roleplay. There is also the opportunity to explore the physical part of being a police officer with several workouts and training exercises completed in each session. Recreational swimming is offered once a week in this camp program.

Forensics II

Ages: 10 - 13 Years

Participants will analyze a more complex crime and be introduced to more advanced methods of evidence collection and analysis. There will also be a fitness component as well as recreational swimming offered once a week in this camp program. We prefer that children complete Forensics I before enrolling in Forensics II but it is not mandatory.

PLANET PROTECTORS CAMP (formerly Climate) - In Partnership with UTM's Innovation & Management Department

Ages: 6 - 12 Years

Inspire the next generation of climate leaders and Earth protectors! Join us this summer for an engaging and impactful camp where campers will learn about the impacts of climate change and be empowered to take action through hands-on, interactive activities. Offered in partnership with the Institute of Management and Innovation (IMI), the camp draws on the expertise of faculty and researchers in sustainability. While primarily classroom-based, the program also includes plenty of fun outdoor and recreational activities such as time in nature, physical activities, games and creative sustainable crafts using eco-friendly materials, giving the perfect balance of learning, creativity, and fun! Recreational swimming is offered once a week in this camp program.

FRENCH CAMP - In Partnership with UTM's Language Studies Department

Ages: 6 - 12 Years

Give your child the gift of language and culture in a fun, supportive setting this Summer! Campers will experience a one-of-a-kind French Immersion camp where learning French is fun, interactive, and immersive! Our camp is led by passionate teacher candidates and graduate students specializing in Language Teaching, ensuring a rich and engaging environment. This inclusive program is open to all children ranging from beginners who want to start learning a new language, or children who already fluent in French. Campers will be placed in small groups based on their current language proficiency, allowing for personalized academic, cultural, and recreational activities tailored to their level. Through dynamic, hands-on workshops, children will develop their language skills while exploring French culture in exciting ways. Our program emphasizes creativity, curiosity, and essential life skills like leadership, communication, and teamwork. Campers will enjoy a balanced mix of cognitive challenges and outdoor adventures. Recreational swimming is offered once a week in this camp program.

PHILOSOPHY CAMPS - In Partnership with UTM's Philosophy Department

NEW! LITTLE THINKERS CAMP

Ages: 6 - 9 Years

Big questions, little thinkers—let curiosity lead the way! In partnership with UTM's Philosophy Department, this camp is an invitation for young thinkers to get curious about big topics: life, art, happiness, and the universe through play-based activities, art, and discussion. Campers will follow their natural sense of curiosity to reflect on the world around them and their place within it. Through these experiences, the camp fosters cognitive development and encourages critical thinking skills, helping children to reason, question, and express their ideas confidently. Campers will encounter the wonder of big philosophical questions and develop the confidence and courage to express their own big ideas. This camp is primarily classroom-based with daily outdoor activities. Recreational swimming is offered once a week in this camp program.

NEW! PHILOSOPHY EXPLORERS CAMP

Ages: 8 - 11 Years

Where wonder meets wisdom: a camp for young philosophers! In partnership with UTM's Philosophy Department, this camp invites young thinkers to explore the big ideas of philosophy through games, creativity, and conversation. Campers will encounter deep ideas about fairness, society, art, knowledge, and reality, and learn to craft and express their own ideas about them. This program will foster cognitive development and strengthen critical thinking skills in campers through engaging discussions, problem-solving activities, and creative exploration. Emphasis is placed on fun, interactive activities, as well as stories and discussions that encourage healthy curiosity and critical reflection on mind-expanding questions about what is real, what is good, what is fair, and how we know. This camp is primarily classroom-based with daily outdoor activities. Recreational swimming is offered once a week in this camp program.

NEW! PERFORMING ARTS CAMP - In Partnership with UTM's Theatre & Drama Studies Program

Ages: 8 - 12 Years

There's no business, like show business! If your child is bursting with creativity, confidence, and curiosity, give them the spotlight to develop their skills at our Performing Arts Camp, offered in collaboration with UTM's Theatre and Drama Studies Program. This unforgettable two-week creative adventure immerses campers in singing, dancing, acting, and show production in a fun, supportive environment led by experienced instructors. During the first week, campers build a strong foundation as they explore vocal performance, movement, and acting while developing confidence, technique, and teamwork and discovering their unique strengths as performers. In the second week, the magic comes to life as campers collaborate to create their very own show based on an exciting theme (TBD - changes for each two-week session), experiencing the full creative process from concept to curtain call. On the last day of the program (Friday of week two), campers take the stage at UTM's Erindale Studio Theatre with two opportunities to present their production to family and friends. Recreational swimming is offered once a week in this camp program

MOVIE MAKING CAMPS - In Partnership with Film Camp in a Box

NEW! STOP MOTION ANIMATION CAMP

Ages: 7 - 11 Years

Lights, camera, LEGO®! In this fun and hands-on camp in partnership with Film Camp in a Box, campers will explore the stop motion animation process including set design, script writing, and editing. Working collaboratively in crews, campers will create their own film using LEGO®, clay and technology. At the end of the week, campers will premiere their short films to family! Recreational swimming is offered once a week in this camp program.

NEW! HOLLYWOOD FILM CAMP

Ages: 9 - 13 Years

Turn your imagination into a movie-making adventure! In this high-energy, hands-on movie-making experience in partnership with Film Camp in a Box, campers will explore the full filmmaking process from pre-production to post-production. Guided by master filmmakers and working in small crews, campers learn scriptwriting, cinematography, AI in film, and editing using tools like Final Cut Pro, iMovie, and Canva. Using professional equipment including 4K cameras, drones, green screens, and boom microphones, campers will create, act in, and edit a short film and movie trailer complete with music, sound effects, and visual effects. Campers will also design promotions and advertisements for their creations. At the end of the week, campers will premiere the short films to family! Recreational swimming is offered once a week in this camp program.

NEW! COMIC & MOVIE TRAILER CAMP

Ages: 9 - 13 Years

Bring your comic book to life and direct an action-packed trailer! In partnership with Film Camp in a Box, campers will work in small crews to create a digital comic book and movie trailer. Through hands-on lessons in cinematography, storyboarding, scriptwriting, comic book photography, and special effects editing, campers will bring heroes and villains to life using 4K cameras and MacBooks. At the end of the week, campers will premiere their blockbuster trailer to family! Recreational swimming is offered once a week in this camp program.
