Course Description:

Students in this course will conduct a research project under the supervision of a faculty member in the Department of Biology. The course is open to third- and fourth-year students.

Students learn how to design, carry out, and evaluate the results of a research project. Students are required to write and present a research proposal, write a term paper, and present a seminar on the results of their research project. All students interested in a research project must approach potential faculty supervisors several months in advance of the beginning of term. Students must obtain permission from the faculty member whom they would like to serve as their project supervisor. Students must meet with the course coordinator periodically throughout the academic year.

Prerequisites: permission of instructor **Exclusions:** <u>BIO400Y5</u> or <u>JCB487Y5</u>

Notes: Summer 2023

The Summer 2023 course is a research only offering, students are expected to spend at least 20 hours per week conducting their laboratory work. If suitable, the department of Biology will hold a mini Symposium at the end of the summer term, where students will present their work.
