Dr. Wendy Bohon completed her PhD in Geology at the Arizona State University. She works as a geologist and science communication specialist at the Incorporated Research Institutions for Seismology in Washington, DC and is on the board of 500 Women Scientists, an organization that focuses on "transformation of leadership, diversity, and public engagement in Science." In addition to her interest in earthquakes, she is also very active in her outreach efforts to improve communication of geologic hazards.
