

University of Toronto Mississauga (UTM) Provostial Non-UTQAP Review 2022-23 Terms of Reference

The Terms of Reference provide the framework of the review report. Reviewers are asked to comment explicitly upon the following:

- 1. The congruence between UTM's academic priorities and the University's long-range plan, in particular, the commitment to excellence in teaching and research.
- 2. Progress towards UTM's academic priorities, including the capacity to meet opportunities and challenges ahead successfully.
- 3. The effectiveness of the approach to undergraduate and graduate education, and its enhancements to support students' academic experience.
- 4. The effectiveness of UTM's efforts to foster a strong culture of excellence and achievement in research and scholarly activity, including the effectiveness of support structures.
- 5. The effectiveness of UTM's internal organizational and financial structure including the appropriateness of resource allocation with respect to budget, faculty complement, infrastructure and advancement.
- 6. The scope and nature of UTM's relationships with other University of Toronto Faculties and Campuses.
- 7. The scope and nature of UTM's societal impact at the local, national, and international levels.
- 8. Extent to which initiatives have been undertaken to enhance the accessibility (e.g., for students requiring physical or mental health accommodations) and diversity (including underrepresented groups) of UTM in the areas of academic programs, student and faculty complement and recruitment.
