As we count down to 2011 – the twentieth anniversary of the founding of this program – we have an extra special season planned for you. In response to popular demand, we'll be creating all new productions of not one but two of our most requested titles from the past. We'll be mounting not one but two world premières. And we'll top it all off with the play many regard as Shakespeare's greatest and most challenging romance.

Our theme this year is "Coming of Age". #### From the Director ...

Creating the overall theatrical narrative of Bernice Eisenstein's 'I Was A Child of Holocaust Survivors', the memoir from which this collective was freely adapted proved to be the least of our challenges. We understood early on that the book's non-traditional, non-linear style somehow mirrored an examined life largely defined by memory that "... is not a place that has been mapped, fixed by coordinates of longitude and latitude, whereby I can retrace a step and come to the same place again. Each time is different. . . ." The real challenge was adding yet another dimension to these already engaging stories. Not only did we need to re-tell them, we had to find a way to relive them while keeping faith with the book. It's a fine line, but with the author's kind permission, we invented 'lines' of our own, and crossed them repeatedly.

Children of Holocaust survivors carry an unusual burden, but you don't come across many who consider their status a form of 'cachet' that they can 'socially trade on.' Yet not only does Eisenstein freely admit to that, she does it with an irreverence and a blend of self-absorption, self-awareness and humour that has made bringing her book to 'life' a rich experience for all of us. I am grateful to the cast and crew for their commitment and their hard work. And for all the laughter. As a child of Holocaust survivors myself, this process went a long way toward diminishing my own struggle with my family's past.

In Bernice's own words...

"As children, we experience things without reflection. Feelings of sadness or joy, the whole range. That self doesn't disappear, but is no longer visible to the outside as we grow older. I had several voices from which I needed to speak through while remembering. So if I put adult words into the speech balloon of a younger self, it was the way in which to create more layers in order to understand where ideas and thoughts and feelings came from, and how they build one on top of the other. Putting adult words into a younger self allowed me to show how ever present the past is. The book, in some ways, is an extended conversation, visually and textually, with myself and to myself, to my parents, to my parents' friends who were also survivors, to ghosts, to the past."

How does one come to terms with the burden of the past?

The answer Bernice Eisenstein offers is to build, nurture and revisit relationships with one loved one at a time. Whether they are a child of the Holocaust or not.

**BERNICE EISENSTEIN** was born in Toronto in 1949. She is an artist whose drawings and illustrations have appeared in a variety of Canadian magazines and periodicals. *I Was a Child of Holocaust Survivors* was the winner of the Canadian Jewish Book Award for Memoir, was a finalist for the Trillium Award, the Borders Original Voices Award, and was a Toronto Star

Best Book of the Year. Publication rights have sold in eleven countries around the world (to date): Canada, the UK, the U.S., Germany, Brazil, Croatia, France, Israel, Italy, the Netherlands, and Spain. Eisenstein lives in Toronto.

Other credits include *Sexy Laundry* (Bluewater Festival), *Kris Kringle' in Miracle On 34th Street* (The Grand), *Colours In The Storm* (Theatre Aquarius), *Noises Off* (Huron Country Playhouse), *Anne Of Green Gables & The Shooting Of Dan McGrew* (Charlottetown Festival), *Thin Ice* (National Arts Centre), *Wild Guys* (Theatre New Brunswick), *Durante* (Jane Mallet/Vancouver Playhouse/US tour) among many others.

Ralph has also work-shopped, acted in, and/or directed dozens of new plays and musicals with companies such as Tarragon Theatre, Miles Nadal (JCC), Script Lab, Buddies in Bad Times/Shaw Festival, Roseneath, and Theatre Orangeville, where he directed mainstage productions of *The Secret Garden* and Jim Betts' *The Mystery Of The Oak Island Treasure*. As the resident director at Toronto Youth Music Theatre Company, he has directed *Guys & Dolls, The Music Man, Once Upon A Mattress*, and *Seussical*. He has also written and directed several musicals for young people, and wrote the book for *Whiskey Serenade*, which premiered at the Toronto Centre for the Arts' Studio Theatre.

**PATRICK YOUNG (Artistic Director)** graduated in English from Victoria College. University of Toronto, trained in Theatre on a graduate scholarship at Indiana University, and was soon a well-known actor across Canada. His Toronto credits included the record-breaking hits Flicks, The Relapse, and the original production of Automatic Pilot, as well as Chinchilla and the last national tour of Spring Thaw. Elsewhere the range included Misalliance in Boston, Uncle Vanya and Tobacco Road in Indiana, Windsor in Charlottetown, Dames at Sea in Winnipeg, Hay Fever across BC and Scapin across Ontario, plus guest starring on such TV series as The Great Detective and Night Heat. During the 1980s, he branched into playwriting, directing, and teaching. He is the author of the award-winning biographical plays "Winnie" (also filmed for television), Aimee! and Abigail, or The Gold Medal, plus numerous industrial shows. He has held the posts of Artistic Director of Dalhousie Theatre Productions in Halifax, Director/Dramaturge of the Music Theatre Writers' Colony at the Muskoka Festival, and Associate Director/Playwright in Residence at the Lighthouse Festival Theatre. Teaching includes Waterloo, Dalhousie, George Brown, Humber, and Gaya College in Malaysia. He is the founding Artistic Director of Theatre Erindale and the founding Sheridan Coordinator of the Theatre and Drama Studies Program (which is now in its twentieth year). For Theatre Erindale he has directed fifteen shows; for Theatre Sheridan two, and elsewhere more than he can count.

#### PETER URBANEK, Manager of Theatre Operations, Set Design

This is Peter's eleventh season at Theatre Erindale. For the past thirty years he has worked in theatres across the country. His past credits include Production Manager for: Magnus Theatre, The University of Western Ontario, Markham Theatre and the Globe Theatre. Peter has over four hundred lighting and set design credits. He has worked with such companies as Mountain Dance Troupe, Vancouver Playhouse, National Ballet, Canadian Opera Company, Taffelmusik, Les Grande Ballets Canadien, Stageright Productions, Fanshawe College, Alberta Ballet Company, and Jabberwocky Theatre for Children. He was production manager, instructor and set/lighting designer for eight years at the University of Western Ontario. For Theatre Safety Consultants he inspected and consulted on over four hundred theatre projects and was theatre consultant for Fanshawe College's Live Performance Industry facility. Peter's movie and television work includes, *The Bridge to Silence* with Lee Remick and Marlee Matlin, *The Super Dave Show, Raffi In Concert, Diamonds*, and *X-Men: The Movie*.

#### JAMES W. SMAGATA, Technical Director, Lighting Design

Jim's passion for theatre began in Grade 7 when he was cast as Major-General Stanley in *The Pirates of Penzance* and title role in *The Sorcerer*. In high school, he performed lead roles in *Our Town*, *The Death and Life of Sneaky Fitch* and *Bus Stop*. For all of these shows he was also set designer and crew. At Brock University he acted in James Reaney's *Listen to the Wind*, Ionesco's *The Killing Game*, *Prometheus Bound* and *Tartuffe*. Jim concentrated on being a technician and landed roles as Technical Director/writer/actor/musician in Rainbow Troupe, Technical Coordinator at Brock, Technical Manager at Grande Prairie Regional College in Alberta, Chief of Production Services at Nepean Centrepointe Theatre, and now as Technical Director at UTM. He has also directed *The Gin Game*, *Portrait in Black, The Creature Creeps!*, *Little Shop of Horrors* and acted and sung as Gandalf in *The Hobbit* and Mike in Jim Betts' *Thin Ice*. He directed the Drama Club's production of *Pump Boys and Dinettes*. He was Technical Director and Lighting Designer for the 2001 Mississauga Arts Council Awards. Jim spends his "spare time" as a post-production engineer and voice actor for several web-based audio dramas.

Angela works primarily in Toronto theatre.
