## **Memo to Chairs and Directors**

RE: Research Opportunity Program - 2024-2025

Dear Colleagues:

We are writing to encourage your participation in the Research Opportunity Program (ROP) for the upcoming 2024-25 cycle. The ROP gives students an opportunity to work with faculty in the development of their research across a broad range of disciplines in an interactive student-teaching partnership. The ROP is part of our continuing efforts to offer students the benefits of an undergraduate education in a research-intensive university. Participating faculty members have also found the experience enormously rewarding since it allowed them to engage one-on-one with undergraduate students in support of their completion of meaningful research projects.

The Office of the Dean provides ROP funding to support student participation in the Program. Allocations of up to \$750 for half-credit courses and \$1,500 for full-credit courses are made based on available funds for the academic year. This funding can assist in offsetting some of the costs (i.e., equipment and supplies) that might be associated with your ROP project. The Program provides flexibility for academic departments to determine the prerequisites and exclusions for student participation. All approved ROP course offerings can be found in the UTM Academic Calendar. Students earn either half (0.5) or one (1.0) course credit by participating in a faculty member's research project. There is no final examination in this program. Students are expected to complete the required hours per week based on the ROP term, keep a journal, and meet regularly with their supervisor. Students are accepted at the discretion of the faculty lead. Grading is determined by the academic unit but must not contravene the University Grading Practices Policy.

The ROP application and selection process is administered entirely online via the <u>ROPAPP</u>. For the upcoming 2024-25 cycle, the ROPAPP will open for faculty project and funding proposal submissions on **Monday**, **January 15**, **2024**, and close on **Monday**, **February 5**, **2024**. Students will have access to the ROPAPP to view and apply your approved project(s) beginning on **Monday**, **February 12**, **2024**.

Please pay careful attention to the dates, deadlines, and important items listed in the ROP Timetable (see below).

To faculty members who had student placements for the 2023-2024 season, thank you for your commitment to the ROP. If you did not have the opportunity to supervise a student, we hope that you will consider submitting a proposal in the upcoming season.
