REFERENCES

Only TWO references are necessary: 1 academic and 1 work/job related.

We only need their names and contact! **Do not ask for reference letters**. You can tell your referees that they could be contacted at any time up to 6-8 months for a verbal reference.

REMEMBER!

ALWAYS use your uToronto email!
- list it on your application CV!

Make sure **all personal info** is up to date on ACORN:

- address, phone, e-mail, emergency contact, etc.

BE PATIENT!

You may get a placement notification any time between March until August!

So check your email **every day** during the summer!

YOUR C.V. (RESUME) AND TRANSCRIPT

Email both your CV and transcript to murray.clayton@utoronto.ca

CURRICULUM VITAE (C.V.)

You MUST use the CV template provided above the application form on the FSC website!

When listing courses on the CV, list **IP** ('in progress') beside all the "S" winter courses you are currently taking, or 'Y' courses not yet completed.

ACORN TRANSCRIPT

You must also send a screenshot or scan of your current ACORN transcript of all marks up to te date of your application. This includes any other universities.

An official (paid) copy is NOT required!

FILE FORMAT

You MUST save your files as both a PDF and WORD doc. with the following formula: LastName_FirstName_doctype.pdf

Example:

Doe_Jane_CV.pdf Doe_Jane_CV.doc Doe_Jane_Marks.pdf Doe_Jane_Marks.pdf

STATEMENTS OF INTEREST

You must provide separate "Statement of Interest" for **each** of your 4 placement options.

Statements should be reflective of each placement area requested, not just copied and pasted. We use it to convince your prospective mentors to take you on.

ADDITIONAL REQUIRED CERTIFICATIONS

DEPENDING ON YOUR PLACEMENT CHOICE, YOUR CHANCES OF SUCCESS MAY REST ON YOUR INTEREST IN FURTHER CERTIFICATION!

If you intend to take **any** professionally related safety/certificate courses (ie. WHMIS, Red Cross Life Saving, Gun Safety and Certification) but have not yet done so, please state this in the appropriate spot on your resume.

Interested in **GUNS/BALLISTICS**? — please make the attempt to get this background so that you have a better chance of being hired at the OPP, RCMP, CFS, Police, Police College after your graduation or in GETTING THIS PLACEMENT NOW.
