

ADVANCED PLACEMENT (AP) EXAMINATIONS

This document indicates how transfer credit is awarded for Advanced Placement (AP) examinations at the **University of Toronto Mississauga**. Please note that the following rules and regulations apply to newly admitted students in the **2020/2021** academic year who are registered in a degree program.

NOTES:

- A **maximum of 3.0 full credits** may be granted provided a **final grade of at least 4** is achieved on each AP examination.
- Final official results must be sent directly from the College Board to [Enrolment Services](#) no later than **July 24, 2020** (U of T's school code is **0982**).

- If you are eligible for more than the 3.0 credit limit, you may request your awarded credits be adjusted/swapped or forfeited, please review the [Request to Forfeit Secondary School Transfer Credit](#) webpage for instructions.
- The deadline to submit a **forfeit or adjustment** request is **September 22, 2020**.
- The option to forfeit is only available to students who have not attended a post-secondary institution. Once forfeited, transfer credits cannot be reinstated.
- If you choose to forfeit transfer credit given for a course for which you were awarded two half credits, you must forfeit both half credits.

GLOSSARY OF TERMS:

Exclusion

U of T courses in which you may not enrol unless you forfeit the transfer credit. In addition, you may not enrol in any courses that are listed in the U of T Mississauga Academic Calendar as exclusions to the awarded transfer credit. If you enrol in courses listed as exclusions, that course will be listed as "extra" on your transcript and will not count towards your degree.

Extra

Courses that are marked as "EXT" or extra are not counted towards your total degree credits (20.0 FCE) and are not included in the GPA, but may be used to satisfy distribution, program, prerequisite, or corequisite requirements.

Distribution Requirement (DR)

To qualify for a degree, students must complete at least 1.0 credit from each of the following divisions: **Humanities, Social Sciences, Sciences**. Distribution requirements are noted for each course (where applicable) with the following:

- HUM = Humanities
- SSc = Social Sciences
- SCI = Sciences

Generic Transfer Credit

A course for which no equivalent discipline exists. Generic credits can be used to satisfy degree and distribution requirements only. They cannot be used towards satisfying program requirements

Unspecified Transfer Credit:

A course that has no exact equivalency in the Faculty. For example, CHM1**Y5 represents an unspecified first year credit in Chemistry. Unspecified credits can be used to satisfy degree and distribution requirements. These credits typically cannot be used to satisfy program requirements. You may wish to check with your department or program area for further clarification.

Subjects not listed below may still be considered for transfer credit.
