**FORMAT OF HEARING:** The Academic Appeals Subcommittee hearing panel consists of no more than seven teaching staff members, and at least one undergraduate student representative. Once you have submitted your appeal, you will be contacted to schedule your appearance in front of the Subcommittee panel and will be required to present your case in person at a meeting convened to hear your case.
