

# 2024 Residence Move-In Guide

## What To Bring

- Clothes
- Toiletries

- Garbage bags
- Cleaning products
- Personal computer
- Extension cords
- Computer/phone chargers
- Laundry bag & detergent

## Before You Arrive

Remember to bring the following items to make your move-in day smooth:

- Move-In Map for your community
- Student Number
- Government-Issued Photo ID
- Citizenship Documents/Study Permit

## Move-In Schedule

1. **Check-In:** Once you have reached your check-in area, please wait in your car until a staff member gives you further instructions. You will then start the check-in process and receive your keys. A staff member will assist you in unloading your car and moving belongings into your room.

2. **Parking:** If you wish to park, please head to designated parking lots to do so. Please only park in the designated lots as those are reserved for move-in day guests and do not leave your car unattended in front of our residence buildings.
3. **Pick-up your T-Card:** Students will be able to pick up T-Cards on move-in day. The I&ITS Service Desk will be open in the CCT Building. You can head there if there are any issues with your T-Card.

## Directions to Residence

Enter through the South Entrance. Residence will be a designated one way traffic for move-in day. Vehicles are to drive around campus towards their designated residence area. If you are in a ride app/taxi, please follow the purple path.

Once you have arrived at your check-in area, please wait until a Student Housing & Residence Life staff member greets you at your car and gives you further instructions. It is important to remain in your vehicle for the safety of our community. Students will be able to check into residence from inside their car and a staff member will assist in unloading your belongings.

Once your car is unloaded, guests will be immediately asked to park their car in the designated parking lots. Please do not leave your car unattended in front of residence buildings. If you become lost, look for UTM Residence directional signs, or staff wearing blue shirts.
