Eligibility:

Students must be enrolled in at least 2.0 FCE (full course equivalent); minimum 0.5 credits in one session and 1.5 credits in the other during the Fall-Winter Term (September 2026 to April 2027). Students are permitted to accept only one Fall-Winter Residence Position per program period. Students do not have to be OSAP eligible to apply for a Fall-Winter Residence Position.

Nature & Scope:

Duties:

- Process evaluation & recommendations for new and existing off-campus housing programs
- Assist in creating off-campus housing promotional and information materials (digital & print)
- Promote and raise awareness of off-campus housing services to all students (resident and non-resident) through tabling and programming
- Direct students, where appropriate, to the correct off-campus housing or campus resources
- Assist with monitoring and responding to inquiries through the off-campus housing email address
- Assist with planning, preparing and presenting off-campus information sessions
- Assist with researching, planning and designing monthly off-campus newsletters
- Facilitate meetings with students to discuss off-campus housing resources
- Researching trends and developing recommendations for improvements to off-campus housing services
- Other duties as assigned
