Welcome Chad

1. Cancellation Policy (Alex)

Why we are revisiting the policy - for transparency and information gathering. Alex provided overview of current policy including various stages and consequences of action. Examples provided to highlight current policy. Handout provided to inform SHAC of other institutional policies. Discussion. Thoughts on Cancellation Fee vs being held Financially Responsible. Mixed feedback. One suggestion was to have a cancellation fee that followed a prorated schedule that increased over time later into the academic year. There was concern about the dollar value of a cancellation fee not being too high. Another suggestion was to not implement a cancellation fee and supported Financial Responsibility. SHRL Admin Team is continuing to review options concerning policy and future considerations.

2. Residence Road Plans (Chad)

Consideration of options for change to reduce speed of vehicles travelling through Schrieberwood Residence. Suggestions made with consideration to Residence Road being a fire access route.

Options under consideration:

1. Installation of four-way stop at intersection north of OPH (immediate).
2. Installation of a cross-walk at RIH (summer).
3. Installation of speed bumps as appropriate (summer).

SHAC feedback – other considerations -

1. Installation of cross-walk to Schrieberwood Laundry Room.
2. Consider making Residence Road one-way, in a north to south direction through that portion of the road through Schrieberwood. It was felt that speeding occurred more frequently in a south to north direction.

3. Misc Feedback

1. Work order program does appear to include options for work required in hallways.
2. Check accessibility doors in RIH near ground for offices.
3. Schrieberwood street light attached to unit #4 appears broken.
