

UTMM Awards

UTMM will be presenting several awards to Undergraduate students to recognize academic, campus and community involvement. Details about each award are available on your Quercus shell as well as on our website:

Awards will be granted to full time students in the Commerce or Management programs who are in good academic standing (Cumulative Grade Point Average of at least 1.50) and are not on academic probation or suspension.

All award recipients will be recognized at the UTMM's Annual Awards Ceremony which will be held in person (pending based on health restrictions) on Wednesday March 31st, 2022.

Nomination Package

All nominations should include the following:

- 1) Nomination form
- 2) Copy of the nominee's unofficial academic transcript
- 3) Copy of the nominee's updated resume (The Department of Management would strongly recommend signing up for a résumé critique from the Career Centre)

Incomplete applications will *NOT* be considered. Please note that students cannot apply for multiple awards. Completed applications should be emailed to <u>graceqf.zhou@utoronto.ca</u> before 3:00 p.m. on March 1st, 2022.

Please note the following:

- 1) Students cannot apply for multiple award categories.
- 2) Previous award recipients are not eligible to apply for the same award category but are welcome to apply for other applicable awards.
- 3) Students that opted to use the Credit/No Credit option in the Winter 2021 term for any MGT or MGM course(s) are ineligible for all award categories.

Award Categories:

Transition Titan Award - ONLY AVAILABLE TO FIRST YEAR STUDENTS

This award is given to 5 current 1st year Commerce or Management students who have demonstrated through their grades, activities and leveraging of campus resources, a successful transition to university. Applicants must have completed less than 5.0 credits and have accumulated at least 30 PSDP points.

As part of the review process, the UTMM Awards Selection Committee will be assessing your academic history. By sending your application, you are giving consent to access your academic history.

Global Citizen Service Award (Internal focus)

This award is given to the Commerce or Management student who through their work, has contributed to peace, rights, education, health, environmental or social justice. Their efforts towards social change have been profound and have impacted the University of Toronto community. Applicants must also be actively involved in the Professional Skills Development Program (PSDP) and have accumulated at least 30 PSDP points.

Global Citizen Service Award (External focus)

This award is given to the Commerce or Management student who through their work, has contributed to peace, rights, education, health, environmental or social justice. Their efforts towards social change have been profound and have impacted the wider community. Applicants must also be actively involved in the Professional Skills Development Program (PSDP) and have accumulated at least 30 PSDP points.

Ambassador Award - ONLY AVAILABLE TO GRADUATING STUDENTS

This award is given to the graduating Commerce or Management student who through their years at UTM, has consistently volunteered or sought leadership opportunities where they represented the Department of Management with enthusiasm and professionalism. Applicant must qualify for and/or have completed the requirements for the Transcript Notation with the Department of Management.



In addition, we have automatic consideration for the following awards:

PSDP Champions Award (Up to 3 awards valued at \$250 each)

This awards 3 current Commerce or Management students who achieved the most PSDP points in one academic year (September - March 1st), thereby demonstrating a commitment to their own professional development and continuous learning.

No application required. PSDP champions are selected by UTMM, based on the total PSDP points as of March 1st.

Academic Excellent Awards (up to 2 awards valued at \$250)- ONLY AVAILABLE TO GRADUATING STUDENTS

This awards the full-time graduating student with the highest CGPA (min. 3.5) in a specialization that academic year. You must qualify for and/or have completed the requirements for the Transcript Notation with UTMM.

- Commerce Award (Accounting, Finance, Marketing or Commerce Specialist)
- o Management Award (Management or Human Resource Management Specialist)
