Accomplishments

- Establishment of a monitoring and evaluation strategy for the duration of the project aimed at improving the quality of services provided and measuring Key Project Indicators.
- Field visitations including data collection, conducting needs assessments for each village and building relationships with the social development center staff.
- Coordination between field staff, office administration, ministry of social affairs and ministry of education and higher education including the recruitment of personnel.
- Procurement of chronic medication, medical equipment, school equipment and identifying construction companies for school rehabilitation through the tender system. This entails creating offer calls and evaluating bids.
