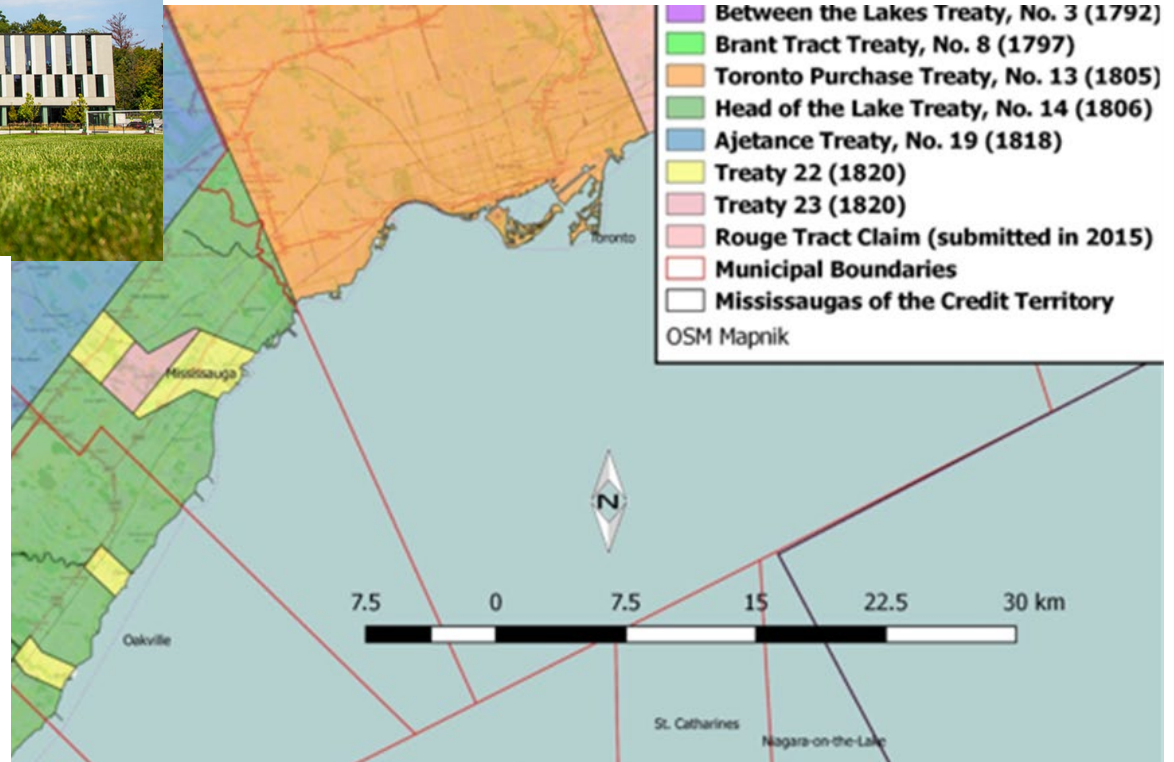

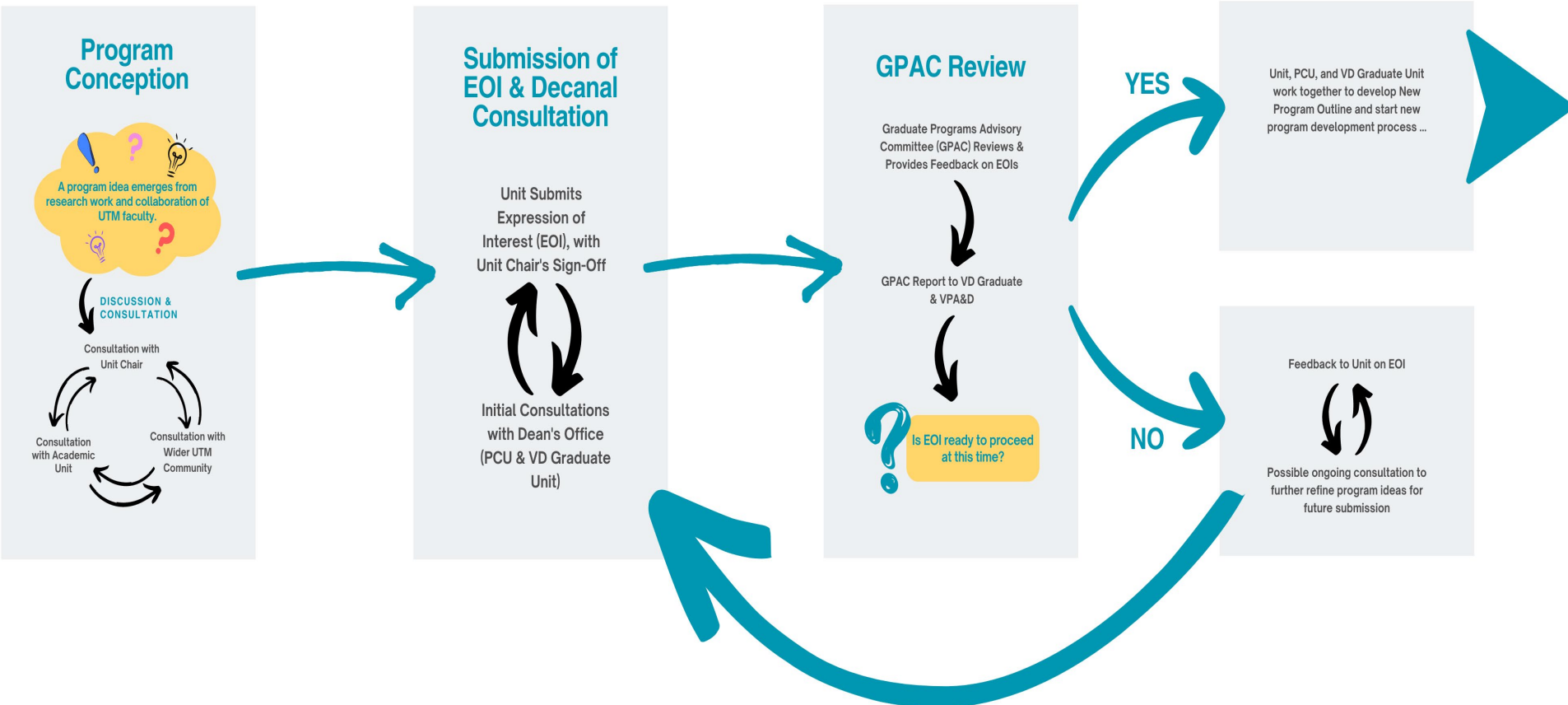


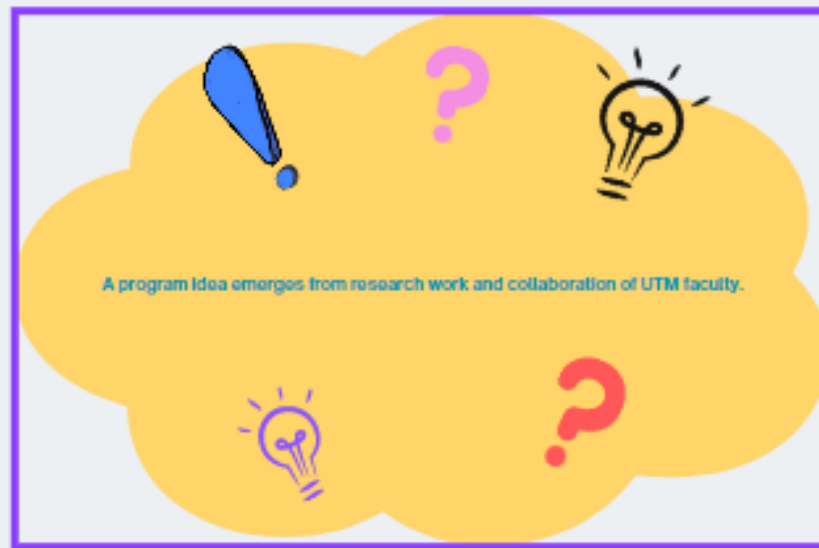
Graduate Programs Advisory Committee

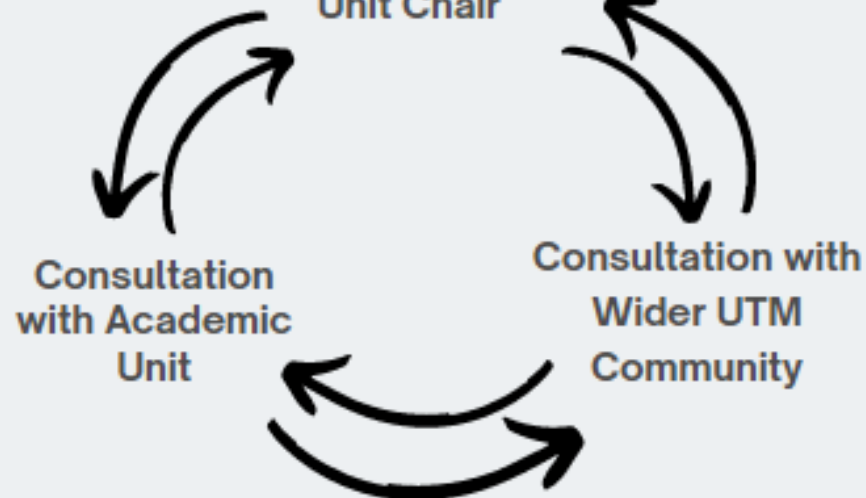
