## Dear Chairs and Directors,

## 1. New Research-Stream Graduate Program Town Hall Slide Deck

# 2. Expression of Interest – call for submissions by May 3, 2023

The Office of the Dean is now accepting <u>Expressions of Interest</u> (EOI) for new research-stream graduate program ideas for review by the Graduate Programs Advisory Committee (GPAC). Any EOI submission must have support from the UTM academic unit and sign-off of the unit's Chair/ Director.

**EOIs received by May 3, 2023 will be presented to GPAC at a late-Spring 2023 meeting**. While this will be the first opportunity to submit an EOI, it will not be the only one. Should you have a program idea that is not ready for EOI submission by the May 3, 2023 deadline, it can be submitted at a later date. EOIs will continue to be brought forward as they are received to the next scheduled bi-annual GPAC meeting. The second GPAC meeting will be held in Fall 2023.
