Phase I - Work Integrated Learning Tags

Tentative Timeline

Units to propose Work Integrated Learning Tags on CM	June 7-25 th , 2021
Office of the Dean to review and provide feedback to units in advance of Fall Curriculum Committee meeting	June 28 th - July 9 th , 2021

- The previous EXP tags have been permanently discarded;
- New institution-wide canonical tagging will be introduced in CM;
- The threshold for the new work-integrated tags will be very different from previous EXP tagging (some previous EXP courses will not qualify for the new tags);
- resources will be available to help units understand the process for adding these tags to courses

Phase II - Permanent Changes to Course Mode of Delivery

Tentative Timeline

Units to propose permanent changes to course mode of delivery on CM	July 12-30 th , 2021
Office of the Dean to review and provide feedback to units in advance of Fall Curriculum Committee meeting	August 2-20 th , 2021

 - We are working to resolve outstanding questions with the Vice-Provost's Office:
 - in-person vs. online vs. hybrid;
 - permanent changes to course mode of delivery requires additional consideration around pedagogy, student impact, program impact, and resourcing.

Phase III - Other Curriculum Changes

Tentative Timeline

Deadline for submitting curriculum changes on CM	October 8, 2021 (Soft deadline for units who wish to preview a draft Curriculum Proposal Report: October 1, 2021)
Office of the Dean to review and provide feedback to units in advance of Fall Curriculum Committee meeting	October 12-22, 2021

- Per the usual curriculum review process, units may submit curriculum change proposals on CM at any time. Proposals received by October 8, 2021 will be presented to the appropriate UG CC at the Fall Curriculum Meetings.
 - > Units are encouraged to submit changes well in advance of the deadline!
- This is the final opportunity to present changes for implementation in the 2022-2023 Academic Year.
