



Requesting Graduation

- Request graduation on ACORN between
 November 23 January 24
- Is your name correct on ACORN?
 - Personal Information Change Form
- Update your mailing address
- Clear outstanding fees and fines
- Grad photos through UTMSU



Caveats

- Missing a deferred exam
- An alleged academic offence (GWR)
- Outstanding fees

*These need to be resolved before you can be eligible to graduate



Other things to consider

- Delaying graduation?
 You can take more courses to improve CGPA
- CGPA is below 1.85?You can still graduate
- Can I take course after graduation?Non-degree student
- Can I request a Graduation Information Letter?


