Disability Support	Accessibility Services: accommodations for physical, learning, sensory & mental health disabilities, medical conditions
Diversity, Equity & Faith	<ul> <li>Equity, Diversity &amp; Inclusion Office: diversity &amp; equity support</li> <li>Health &amp; Counselling Centre: gender identity &amp; sexual orientation</li> <li>Centre for Student Engagement: connection to campus faith leaders &amp; clubs</li> </ul>
Family Responsibilities	UT Family Care: info, support & workshops on family leave, childcare, elder-care
Finances, Financial Aid & Scholarships	<ul> <li>Office of the Registrar: financial aid advising including OSAP appeals, UTAPS and UTM Grants; RESP forms</li> <li>Awards Explorer: https://awardexplorer.utoronto.ca to view all awards, bursaries &amp; scholarships at U of T (filter for UTM)</li> </ul>
International Support & Global Opportunities	International Education Centre: studying abroad & international exchange opportunities, study permits, transition issues, work eligibility, immigration support

Physical & Mental Health	<ul> <li>Health &amp; Counselling Centre: physicians, nurses, health educators; also counsellors for issues like relationships, grieving, anxiety, etc.; workshops on stress management</li> <li>U of T Telus Health Student Support: 24-hour phone, web &amp; app support for students' school, health &amp; general life concerns</li> <li>Recreation, Athletics &amp; Wellness Department: broad range of casual, competitive, individual, instructional &amp; team activities</li> </ul>
Safety	<ul> <li>UTM Police: emergency, safety and crisis support 24/7</li> <li>Sexual Violence Prevention &amp; Support Centre: safety planning, victim support</li> <li>WalkSafer Service: walking escorts across campus, including after-hours</li> </ul>
Time Management	<ul> <li>Centre for Student Engagement: peer-led workshops, mentors, programs</li> <li>Academic Skills Centre: workshops, coaching</li> </ul>
