Disability Support	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Accessibility Services: accommodations for physical, learning, sensory & mental health disabilities, medical conditions
Diversity, Equity & Faith	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Equity, Diversity & Inclusion Office: diversity & equity support • Health & Counselling Centre: gender identity & sexual orientation • Centre for Student Engagement: connection to campus faith leaders & clubs
Family Responsibilities	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • UT Family Care: info, support & workshops on family leave, childcare, elder-care
Finances, Financial Aid & Scholarships	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Office of the Registrar: financial aid advising including OSAP appeals, UTAPS and UTM Grants; RESP forms • Awards Explorer: https://awardexplorer.utoronto.ca to view all awards, bursaries & scholarships at U of T (filter for UTM)
International Support & Global Opportunities	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • International Education Centre: studying abroad & international exchange opportunities, study permits, transition issues, work eligibility, immigration support
Involvement & Making Social Connections	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • UT & UTM student organizations: academic societies, student governments, 100+ clubs across cultural, service, political, faith & other interests • Centre for Student Engagement: leadership, service & co-curricular opportunities • Career Centre: student employment, volunteer & service opportunities • Wellness Den: self-care workshops, mindfulness activities • Recreation, Athletics & Wellness Department: competitive & recreational teams, fitness classes, work-outs
Internet & Computing Issues	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Info & Instructional Technology Services: internet & wifi connectivity, university email & passwords, privacy & scam protection, online/remote learning tools
Physical & Mental Health	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Health & Counselling Centre: physicians, nurses, health educators; also counsellors for issues like relationships, grieving, anxiety, etc.; workshops on stress management • U of T Telus Health Student Support: 24-hour phone, web & app support for students' school, health & general life concerns • Recreation, Athletics & Wellness Department: broad range of casual, competitive, individual, instructional & team activities
Safety	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • UTM Police: emergency, safety and crisis support 24/7 • Sexual Violence Prevention & Support Centre: safety planning, victim support • WalkSafer Service: walking escorts across campus, including after-hours
Time Management	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Centre for Student Engagement: peer-led workshops, mentors, programs • Academic Skills Centre: workshops, coaching
