

UTM 50th Anniversary Legacy Fund

Selection Criteria (all five criteria required)

1. Overall Impact: Makes a lasting impact and has a broad reach within the UTM community. This impact will profile UTM as an innovator in teaching and outreach or enhance student life, programs, services and physical property that benefits the campus.
2. Environmental Sustainability: Plays a crucial role in protecting the environment and without compromising the ability of future generations to solve modern sustainability challenges in Canada and around the world.
3. Equity & Diversity: Promotes an equitable and inclusive campus community, free from discrimination or harassment based on age, disability, race, ancestry, place of origin, colour, ethnic origin, citizenship, creed, sex, gender expression, gender identity, sexual orientation, family status, marital status, and/or record of offences.
4. Accessibility: Respects the dignity and independence of people with disabilities; facilitates their inclusion into all aspects of university life.
5. Community Engagement: Involves community engagement within the UTM community, across campuses or with local or global communities with an eye to making connections between people (students, faculty, staff and community members)

Themes (one criteria required)

1. Remembering the Past: Reflects on UTM's past by using communication channels including: in-person, print, digital, video, audio and/or other platforms.
2. Capturing the Present: Captures current interests and activities at UTM to showcase the future including: artistic representations, graphs/diagrams or other forms of expression.
3. Looking Ahead: Celebrates UTM's boundless potential through projects that have links to future programming, creating a unique record or building enduring relationships.
